A MESSAGE FROM OUR RECTOR

The Thirty-First Sunday in Ordinary Time – November 3, 2024



Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Welcome to Christ Cathedral, a sacred haven where all who seek the grace of God are embraced. We are truly overjoyed by your presence as we gather in the love and light of our Lord. On behalf of Bishop Kevin Vann, the devoted Shepherd of our Diocese and Pastor of Christ Cathedral, we extend our deepest gratitude for joining us in this blessed moment. Your attendance is a beautiful reflection of your faith, commitment, and the strength of our shared community. May the Lord pour out His abundant blessings upon our worship and may His everlasting joy and peace fill each of our hearts today and always!

LOVE OTHERS AS JESUS LOVES US. Today's readings invite us to love God by loving others and to find God in the act of loving those around us. In other words, we love God by recognizing and honoring His presence within each person. The first reading shows Moses urging us to love God through faithful obedience to His commandments, which brings both blessing and reward. The second reading reveals Jesus, our eternal High Priest, offering Himself on the cross – a profound act of love – so we may know God's love for us. In the Gospel, we hear the Mosaic Laws: "Hear, O Israel, the Lord our God is Lord alone! Therefore, you shall love the Lord, your God, with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your strength" (Deuteronomy 6:4), and "You shall love your neighbor as yourself" (Leviticus 19:18). Jesus calls us to show our love for God in how we genuinely and actively care for others. This love is the heart of a true relationship with God. Every prayer, every scripture reading, every sacrament, and every act of worship is meant to deepen this love. To live this out, we place God's will above our own, seeking to live in harmony with His desires for us. This love extends beyond self-interest, as we are called to love one another as Jesus loves us. As we prepare to approach the altar and receive the Holy Eucharist, let us take a moment of silent reflection, recognizing Jesus in this Most Blessed Sacrament. With hearts open and trusting, let us ask for forgiveness where we have failed in love. Let us make sacrifices to meet the needs of others, offer our time to those who may need us, and reach out in prayer and kindness to those who are suffering. May our hearts, filled with love, reflect God's love to everyone we encounter. With the help of God, let us try to make it happen at least one time during this week.

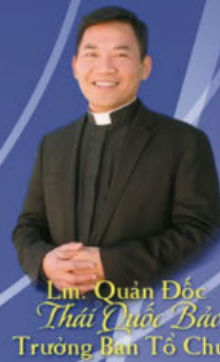

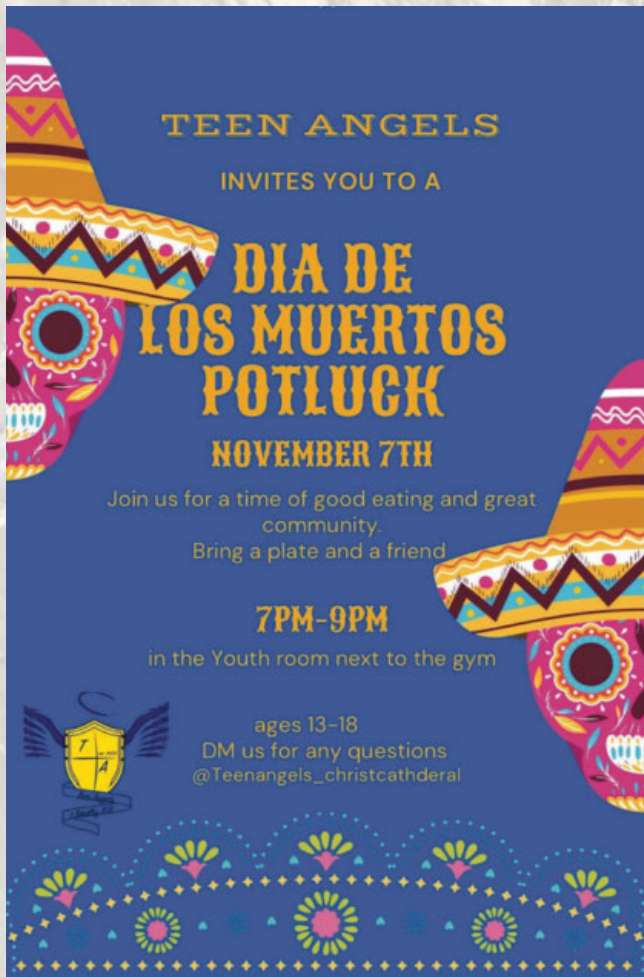

Forming Consciences for Faithful Citizenship

In their statement on *Forming Consciences for Faithful Citizenship*, the Catholic bishops of the United States identify the four main principles of the Church's social teaching and apply them to some concrete issues. This is not to tell the faithful for whom or against whom to vote, but instead to help them form their consciences in accordance with God's truth as they approach this often challenging decision. The four main principles are the Dignity of the Human Person, the Common Good, Solidarity, and Subsidiarity. They are all interrelated.



Dignity of the Human Person - Because each human person is created in the image and likeness of God, each one of us possesses innate and inviolable human dignity. The dignity of the human person is the foundation for a moral vision of society. As we seek to imitate the Good Samaritan and become neighbor to all, we must work to protect the dignity of all, especially those who are most vulnerable. (See Pope Francis, *Fratelli Tutti*, no.107)

Common Good - The Common Good is "the sum total of social conditions which allow people, either as groups or as individuals, to reach their fulfillment more fully and more easily" (Catechism, no.1906). Human dignity is respected and the common good is fostered only if human rights are protected and basic responsibilities are met.

Solidarity - Solidarity is "a firm and persevering determination to commit oneself to . . . the good of all and of each individual, because we are all really responsible for all" (St. John Paul II, *Sollicitudo Rei Socialis*, no.38). We are one human family, whatever our national, racial, ethnic, economic, and ideological differences. The person is social in nature; we develop and flourish within a community. As baptized members of the community of the Church, we are part of one body in Christ and we are also part of one global human family (Benedict XVI, *Deus Caritas Est*, no.25b).

Subsidiarity - Larger institutions in society should not overwhelm or interfere with smaller or local institutions, yet larger institutions have essential responsibilities when the more local institutions cannot adequately protect human dignity, meet human needs, and advance the common good (*Forming Consciences for Faithful Citizenship*, no.48).

It is our responsibility to learn more of Catholic teaching and tradition, to participate in Church life, to learn from trustworthy sources about the issues facing our communities, and to do our best to make wise judgments about candidates and government actions. These decisions should take into account a candidate's commitments, character, integrity, and ability to influence a given issue. Thus equipped, and further impelled by our sense of patriotism, we exercise our right and duty to vote and otherwise to participate actively in public life (Catechism, nos.2239-40). By forming our consciences for faithful citizenship, we can better pursue the common good and thus obey the command of our Lord to love our neighbors.

Formando la conciencia para ser ciudadanos fieles

En su declaración *Formando la conciencia para ser ciudadanos fieles*, los obispos católicos de los Estados Unidos identifican los cuatro principios fundamentales de la Doctrina Social de la Iglesia y los aplican a algunas cuestiones concretas. No se trata de decirles a los fieles por quién o contra quién votar, sino de ayudarlos a formar sus conciencias de acuerdo con la verdad de Dios a medida que se acercan a esta decisión a menudo desafiante. Los cuatro principios fundamentales son la Dignidad de la persona humana, el Bien común, la Solidaridad y la Subsidiariedad. Todos están interrelacionados.



La dignidad de la persona humana - Debido a que cada persona humana es creada a imagen y semejanza de Dios, cada uno de nosotros posee una dignidad humana innata e inviolable. La dignidad de la persona humana es el fundamento de una visión moral de la sociedad. Mientras buscamos imitar al Buen Samaritano y convertirnos en prójimos de todos, debemos trabajar para proteger la dignidad de todos, especialmente de aquellos que son más vulnerables. (Ver Papa Francisco, *Fratelli Tutti*, n.107)

El bien común - El Bien común es "el conjunto de aquellas condiciones de la vida social que permiten a los grupos y a cada uno de sus miembros conseguir más plena y fácilmente su propia perfección" (*Catecismo*, n.1906). La dignidad humana es respetada y el bien común promovido sólo si se protegen los derechos humanos y se cumplen las responsabilidades básicas.

Solidarity - La Solidaridad es "la determinación firme y perseverante de empeñarse por . . . el bien de todos y cada uno, para que todos seamos verdaderamente responsables de todos" (San Juan Pablo II, *Sollicitudo Rei Socialis*, n.38). Somos una familia humana, independientemente de nuestras diferencias nacionales, raciales, étnicas, económicas e ideológicas. La persona es de naturaleza social; nos desarrollamos y prosperamos dentro de una comunidad. Como miembros bautizados de la comunidad de la Iglesia, somos parte de un solo cuerpo en Cristo y también somos parte de una familia humana global (Benedicto XVI, *Deus Caritas Est*, n.25b).

Subsidiariedad - Las instituciones más grandes de un país no deberían abrumar o interferir con las instituciones que son más pequeñas o tienen carácter local. Sin embargo, las instituciones más grandes tienen responsabilidades esenciales cuando las instituciones locales no pueden adecuadamente proteger la dignidad humana, responder a las necesidades humanas y promover el bien común (*Formando la conciencia para ser ciudadanos fieles*, n.48).

Es nuestra responsabilidad aprender más sobre la enseñanza y la tradición católicas, participar en la vida de la Iglesia, aprender de fuentes confiables sobre las cuestiones que enfrentan nuestras comunidades y hacer todo lo posible para hacer juicios sabios sobre los candidatos y las acciones gubernamentales. Estas decisiones deben tener en cuenta los compromisos, el carácter, y la integridad del candidato, así como su capacidad para influir en una cuestión determinada. Así equipados, y aún más impulsados por nuestro sentido de patriotismo, ejercemos nuestro derecho y deber de votar y de participar activamente en la vida pública (*Catecismo*, nn.2239-40). Al formar nuestra conciencia para ser ciudadanos fieles, podemos buscar mejor el bien común y así obedecer el mandato de nuestro Señor de amar a nuestro prójimo.
